



Canadian Motorcycle Hall of Fame Announces Inaugural Inductees – Presentations to be held on May 6

March 30, 2006 Toronto, Ontario The Canadian Motorcycle Hall of Fame Museum (CMHM), sponsored by the International Motorcycle SUPERSHOW (IMS), and the Motorcyclists Confederation of Canada (MCC) has announced twelve individuals and organizations to be inducted at the first annual Hall of Fame Induction Banquet, to be held May 6 in Mississauga, Ontario.

“We have a broad cross-section of Canadian motorcycling achievement in this group”, says Bar Hodgson, Chairman of the CMHM. “We had many nominations from across the country and all types of motorcycling activity – competitors, business people, and organizations.
